SESSION FORMATS

3. SKILLS SESSION: A session led by a senior scholar where a specific skill is taught and junior scholars have the opportunity to ask questions. This could include topics such as “how to turn a dissertation into a book/article” or “how to secure a publishing contract.”

4. CONSULTATION: This format has traditionally been geared towards early career students and researchers, but we also welcome more established scholars who just need a thought partner to take advantage of this session.

5. PRACTITIONER RESEARCH SESSION: Practitioners, often collaborating with researchers, present research designed to provide practical ideas and strategies for immediate use in educational settings, with time for discussion and feedback.
